SUBJECT : Threatening betters Received from Former Crainees

In accordance with your request, I am listing below the actions taken concerning the threatening letters received at the Political Sation School.

- 1. On 16 September a cable was received from Munich stating that two former trainees of the SHELDHE Political Action School were threatening to ormpromise the school. These two individuals were students of the original class at the PA School but were returned to Germany shortly after their survival because they were not considered suitable for training.
- 2. On 17 September the SN Division sent a cable to Munich recommending, first, that the Ukrainian Ruigre Organization with which they are connected publish a statement that certain unscrupulous individuals were attempting blackmail. The purpose of this statement was to diminish any derogatory effects of information that these termen might give the press. Secondly, a cable asked the field to take them that their unvarianted attacks would adversely effect any emigration possibilities and the Ukrainian revolutionary movement. Thirdly, it maked the emigro organization to exact its control over these people.
- And On 3.October the 1A School received another letter this time from the other was (%2.50%) in which he stated he was in a hopeless condition and, therefore, was folded to make certain demands. He demanded 1) either payment of a one year salary of \$150.00 a month less the amount that he has already raceived, or 2) a secure position in Turope or America, or 3) immediate emigration to the

EE, in conjunction with the them sent out a cable on the 6th of Gatober which noted the pracipt of the two letters, asked the field to hendle this situation on a priority basis and report their progress.

- 7. On 7 October the field realied that they would ask Pl's and 507 to report to the Hicog building on 13 October to discuss natters of official nature. The cable said that two case officers dressed as Army officers would interview the two men and that their degree of toughness and any threats to be used would be dependent upon the reactions of the former students. The valle also requested headquarters concurrence. On 8 October EE asbled its concurrence but recommended that contact with the individuals be made some other way then in writing.
- 9. Attached for your information is the background of the two students concerned.
