In Sep '51 Subject was involved in the irregular use of an altered Duty Rail Ticket when he made a sudden, urgent trip; Zipper's Apr '52 report to POB explaining the incident described Cornelius van der BORST as "very reliable, honest and industrious covorker, who is particularly successful in investigating new commections. He was considerably active in the [ ] (W-DROLLERY #1209) case and at present time is establishing excellent connections into Poland." An Oct '51 Zipper report stated COMMY's publishing house KUESTEM-VERIAG, Hamburg 1, Ballimiass 26 ('53 Bmb tel. dir.) was very much in debt. COMMY had been offered MPD aid and would find it difficult to plausibly refuse, so Zipper made efforts to obtain credit for him from ministries in Bonn to prevent the business coming under EPD control Oct 153: POB's has impression COMMY works for Zipper primarily because his business was in financial difficulty and believes CORMY to be source of a report to effect that Fritz HEIRE, SPD Secretary, had received 450,000 DM from the SED for 1953 election; Zipper considered this report sensitive and unreliable, extremely SEESITIVE and should not be disseminated or acted upon).

Subject's connections included persons suspected of activities for the Soviets and former EU leaders who support the Soviet line in Western Germany.
