1. Reference is made to your letter No. 3398, subject as above, dated 21 October 1953, requesting Central Registry check.

2. In compliance with your request, the names on the attachment were checked against the files of Central Registry, 66th CIC Group. No record was disclosed with the following exception:

Cornelius van der HORST, your trace. A trace is held on one Cornelius van der HORST (date and place of birth unknown), residence given as Ballindam 26, HAMBURG 1, in February 1952, who attended the Neutralist Congress of the Dritte Front (Third Front Movement) in HAMBURG in February 1952. (B-3) A trace is also held on one Cornelius van der HORST (date and place of birth unknown) who was reported by an American intelligence agency in February 1952 to be the leader of the Helfende Haende (Helping Hands), an organization in HAMBURG made up of former SS members. (C-6)
