2. FYI: Subject 1 (a) above was until recently a Kriminalrat serving with the Sicherungsgruppe in Bonn. He joined the UPSWING staff during 1957 and replaced @ BERNHARD as chief of the Incidents Section on the Operational Security Staff. During the course of liaison he has mentioned he is a professional police official and served in the "Kripo" in Berlin during World War II. We therefore think it likely that there may be a trace on him in the BDC files.

Subject 1 (b) above is the deputy for @ PETERS, the chief of UPSWING Staff Security. He claims to be a career police official and visited the U.S. in 1951 or 1952 on a HICOG sponsored tour of U.S. police installations including those of the Michigan State Police.
