Enver Hoxha

Born at Argirocastro in 1908 of family of small land owners. Studied at French Lycée of Korcia, and then at the University of Montpellier. From 1932 to 1936, during his stay in France, worked with French Communist Party. In 1937 was at Brussels as a secretary in the Albanian Legation. In 1938 recalled to Albania and assigned to teach in Lycée of Durres. In 1939 to escape such duties, undertook clandestine activities. In 1941 named General Secretary of the Albanian Communist Party (later Workers Party) position he still retains. From 1945 to 1954, intermittently filled position of Head of the Government.

In his youth he left very much to be desired.
