SUBJECT: Franz HUBER

In connection with BONN 6973, 8 May 58, request for traces and info whether Subj ever refused visa by US:

a. 13 June 58: [] of Security 'phoned results of preliminary check with I&NS. Up to Sep '57 no indication HUBER ever in U.S. Correspondence between I&NS and some other govt agency indicates in 1950 HUBER claimed he had visa for visit to visit U.S. but his trip did not materialize. Prior to 1954 he applied for an Australian visa for business purposes but was denied entry; later he did get a visa for transit to New Zealand.

b. 18 June 58: [] of Security telephoned results of his State Dept check. In June 1957 issuance of visa to Subj was recommended against because HUBER failed to disclose material facts concerning his background. State at that time was overruled by the American Consul General and a visa was granted 12 Dec 1957 in Duesseldorf. Derogatory info concerns Subj's activities in the Gestapo. However, as stated by [] according to I&NS he has never entered the U.S.
