1. Our delay in replying to reference is regretted, however it was necessary to up-date Headquarters records on Subject before a meaningful reply could be given.

2. ODACID files were checked by KUSODA in 1958 and revealed that Subject was first granted a visa to PBPRIME in 1957. In June 1957, after Subject's application for a visa in Duesseldorf, Germany, the responsible ODACID Field Officer recommended that Subject be found inadmissible to PBPRIME on the basis of his background and his failure to disclose a number of material facts connected therewith. The Officer concluded that Subject represented a security risk to PBPRIME. ODACID headquarters replied on 2 December 1957 that their files disclosed no derogatory information regarding the applicant that was not already available to the field office. The memorandum also advised that a PBPRIME military officer who had been in the Shanghai area during the post-war period and had participated in both the examination of Subject and the preparation of his case for prosecution reported Subject as having been then cooperative and informative. After a thorough review of the circumstances of this case, ODACID headquarters did not concur with the Field determination that Subject was ineligible for admission to PBPRIME. As a result, ODACID Duesseldorf granted Subject a non-immigrant visa on 12 December 1957 valid for multiple entries for a four-year period. In view of the following information it is assumed this visa has been periodically renewed.

- 7 to 8 November 1963
- 28 November 1963
- 16 to 23 June 1964
- 30 April to 10 May 1965

3. The above information has not been cleared for passage to and is forwarded for your information only. It would suffice to advise that Subject is no longer restricted from entering PBPRIME.
