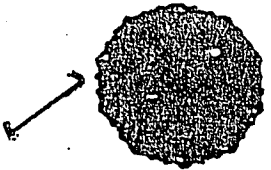

Reference is made to your memorandum dated August 11, 1953, your indicator CS DB 6635, advising some Iron Guard publications had been printed in an Iron Guard clandestine print shop in Salzburg, Austria. You desired to know if any of the publications had been forwarded from Salzburg to George Sabau in Dallas, Texas.

In accordance with your request, an appropriate investigation will be conducted in Dallas, Texas, and you will be advised of the results.

Regarding the other remarks in your letter, you are advised that, other than the information received from you, we have no information that there is an organized Iron Guard movement in the United States. We have investigated individuals who allegedly hold Iron Guard sympathies and pertinent results of these investigations have been furnished you. Specifically, reports were furnished you concerning Nicolae M. Smarandescu and Tiberiu Dumita. Regarding the possible exploitation of the Rumanian Orthodox Church, you have been furnished pertinent reports regarding (Reverend) Andrew Moldovan and Viorel Trifa.

We would appreciate being furnished any additional information you may obtain regarding Iron Guard activities in the United States.
