Grand Mufti of Jerusales (former)

Born Amin al-HUSAYNI, at Jerusalem, probably in 1893. The Husaynis were one of the 2 most prominent Arab Palestinian families and claimed descent from the Prophet Muhammed. The rank of Mufti, bestowed upon subj's father, Tahir al-Husayni, by the Ottoman Govt, signified that the bearer was an elder religious leader in the community. Amin's elder half-brother, Kamel, was similarly honored.

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Subj attended St.George's School in Jerusales, then went to al-Azhar Univ in Cairo. He made the pilgrimage to Maccs, received the title of Haj, then went to Turkey where he served in the Turkish Army during WW I. After the cavitulation of the Ottoman Empire in 1918, he was attached to the British Fublic Security Service in Falestine, dhanging over later to work for the French Secret Service in Damascus. He apeaks English, French, Turkish & Arabic.
