Subject: Liaison

1. Paragraph 7, Changes No. 2 to CIG Administrative Order No. 6, dated 12 August 1946 is quoted below:

"7. ICAPS will establish and coordinate the procedures relative to CIG liaison and contacts with the participating agencies of the United States Government pertaining to intelligence and will coordinate the working liaison arrangements and procedures relating to intelligence established by the operating offices of CIG with participating agencies of the United States Government."

2. To implement the desire of the Director that all liaison with other Government agencies be initiated and controlled by this office the attached draft of Operations Memorandum No. 1 is submitted for publication to all activities of CIG.

3. It is planned to issue data from this office from time to time in the form of operations memorandums when subject matter warrants this form of publication.

Operations Memorandum No. 1

1. Reference is made to paragraph 7, Changes 2 to CIG Administrative Order No. 6, dated 12 August 1946.
2. All CIG liaison contacts with other agencies of the Government will be made initially by ICAPS.
3. Liaison requirements of other activities of the CIG will be referred to ICAPS for action.
4. At such time as appropriate plans and policies are developed certain direct liaison functions may be delegated to other CIG activities. In such cases, rigid adherence to established policies will be required, and copies of all direct correspondence in connection with authorized direct liaison will be sent to ICAPS. This will not include the normal exchange of information and intelligence data.
5. The Executive for Personnel and Administration will insure that no liaison matters are cleared to other Government agencies without reference to ICAPS, except those matters specifically covered by separate written authority under paragraph 4 above.
