SUBJECT: Intelligence Relations between U.S. and British

1. There have been several recent newspaper reports concerning the closeness of intelligence relations between the U.S., the British, and the Canadians. ICAPS has seen nothing official in this same direction. A broad policy statement which will guide CIG is therefore requested.



4. ICAPS can make no recommendations until the basic policy or principle has been enunciated for CIG.
