1. Field representatives of this Alency were advised that in the event of Mr. Robert Vogeler's release from prison in Mungary, they are to give every assistance to his expeditious movement to the United States without interrogation in the field.

2. You are probably aware of the fact that this Agency has conducted a considerable amount of experimentation along the lines indicated in your paragraph 2. The natter is naturally one of priority operational interest to this Agency. I request, therefore, that my representative be given an opportunity to discuss the results obtained by the interrogation of Mr. Vogeler, as well as the major implications in terms of medical research and interrogation techniques with the responsible officer in charge of the Navy's project.
