Imam Musa Sadr was last seen in Tripoli, Libya on 31 August 1978. Libyan officials claim he left Libya on that date on Alitalia flight 881 for Rome and they claim that his baggage was discovered at the Holiday Inn in Rome several days later when he failed to contact friends in the city.
