1. Re Lt. General ~~ISHII~~ Shiro I have very little in my own files outside of a map, which I submitted, showing the location of his home. The accompanying report merely stated that ISHII was well-known to many espionage agents but that SCAP discouraged interviews. He appears to be in financial straits and for this reason, it is reported, turned his house into a hotel. However, because of poor location, it is doing badly.

2. In November 1949 I received the following documents from [] both of which have brief reference to Subject.

- a) An Interrogation of YAMADA Hidetaka, Colonel, a repatriate from Russia
- b) "Report on Scientific Intelligence Survey in Japan, September and October 1945, Volume V, Biological Warfare, 1 November 1945".

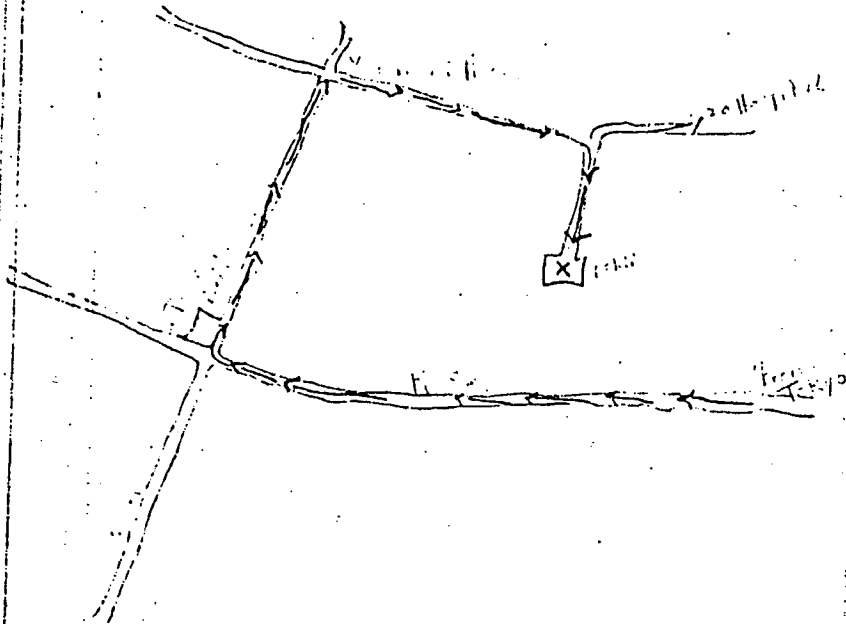

Directions to home of Maj. Gen. ISHII

Go out K Street to 30th Street (ISETAN DEPT STORE, SHINJUKU), turn right on 30th Street to Yodobashi Avenue; turn right on Yodobashi Avenue until the road takes a jog to the left toward the hospital; instead of turning left with the road, turn right down a very narrow dirt lane.

The lane dead-ends into a hotel. This is ISHII's home which he has converted into a hotel. (see also: ZJLA-321)
