ISSEL took over the leadership of the "Peter Group" in late Nov. of 1944. He kept this job up to the capitulation.

The most important member of the "Peter-group" now at large is undoubtedly (Hauptsturmfuhrer) ISSEL. He is an extremely dangerous person, who would not shy any means to attain his object, and it is of paramount importance that really effective action is taken to trace him. It has been found that he left Copenhagen on May 4th, 1945 about 1700 hours en route to Jutland (Jylland). He did not, however, succeed in getting away from Sealand (Sjælland), and he was last seen on the 5th of May, 1945, when he was driving in a car going North along Highway No. 1. The description of him is: age: about 33, height: 182 cm. Approx. slim; hair'blonde, protuding chin, eyes: cat-like.

He has poison hidden in a tie pin and is in possession of two fountain pens, one with toxic gas, and the other is a pistol.
