Subject:/ Action against Denuncia

1. The attached reports from AMCALTTTER/1 indicate that Pedro Leyva, allegedly a paid employee of AMBUD, is the brains behind an anti-Batista publication named Denuncia, and that AMBUD/1 took the trouble to state to AM LATTER/1 that he, AMBUD/1, had nothing to do with the paper.

2. AMBUD/1's concern on the matter may have stemmed ~~from~~ from the fact that on page 8 of the 17 October issue of Denuncia there was an ~~xxxxxxvvt~~ article which exposed ~~xxxxxtavxxxxxyt~~ Mach#o Barquer and Joaquin Sanjenis as agents of the CIA.

3. Concerned case officers in PW and FI Sections, as well as Chief PM, who is preturbed about the mention in the same paragraph of Manuel Villanfana, feel that if it can be ascertained that an employee of AMBUD is connected with Denuncia, his pay should be terminated summarily as an example to anyone else who might ~~xxx~~ decide that such activity will be countenanced by ODOYKE.

4. It is suggested, therefore, that the matter be taken up with AMBUD/1 soonest, and that a thorough investigation be made by AMBUD of the alleged extra-curricular activities of Leyva, and if results confirm suspicions, his services be terminated.

SUBJECT: "DENUNCIA" newspaper.

On the 17th and 18th of October the newspaper "DENUNCIA" was distributed free in all centers attended by Cubans (and on all the doors of the Refugee Center).

Every person who arrived at Dr. Jose MIRO Cardona's home was given one, two, or three copies. MIRO-Cardona himself advised persons to read the section "Panel".

The director of this newspaper, Jesus GONZALEZ Cartas, was in Dr. MIRO Cardona's home, and was received by Dr. MIRO with "abrazos".

Jesus GONZALEZ Cartas and Humberto RODRIGUEZ Diaz are known in Cuba and in exile as gangsters and as being involved with narcotics. Especially Humberto RODRIGUEZ Diaz.

NOTE: Dr. Carlos PRIO Socarras collected \$1,350.00 for this newspaper. For the coming issue, ZAYDEN was demanded to give \$1,000.00.

Although he does not appear listed in the editorial staff of the newspaper, it is well known that Mr. Pedro LEIVA Ugarriza has a big participation in it.

REPORT NO. 20

Miami, Oct. 31, 1962.-

SUBJECT: Meeting with Dr. Miró Cardona of the
CRC.

On Saturday morning, Oct. 20th., 1962, I visited Dr. Miró Cardona, at his home in Miami Beach, accompanied by Carlos Peláez, a personal friend, who had informed me Dr. Miró requested this visit.

Dr. Miró conversed about Conte Agüero, commenting his activities which appear to have caused him a great deal of concern.

He said the reason he desired to see me, was to assure me he had no connection with Jesús González Cartas, alias "El Extranño", well known Cuban gangster, that has recently published a newspaper in this area, titled "Denuncia". He added that although "El Extranño" had visited him on several occasions, requesting economical aid, he had not given him any assistance.

Dr. Miró spoke on other subjects, specially in reference to his desire that all factions of the 20th. of May, reunite and enter the Council. On questioning him as to which personality of the different factions he desired to represent the Organization, he stated that he would give his backing to a man named Mariño, explaining he desired to have a colored personality in the CRC setup. Mariño, he said, was an old friend, and had been President of the "Ateneo Club" in Cuba, (a Cuban Negro civic Organization). This came to me as quite a surprise, as Mariño, a not very well known personality in this area, is known to have been a member of the MRP of the Catholic Action sector, with no previous connection with the 20th. of May Organization.

On speaking of the Democratic Christian Movement, Dr. Miró stated that he was in favor of the unification of this sector, but that the CIA were interested in the faction represented by Alberto del Junco, and although he had intervened personally in trying to unite Del Junco with Fernández Badde (Lucas), he had found that impossible to do, adding that it would be easier to get Lucas together with the rest of the Organization, now headed by Ernesto Rodríguez, than to reconcile Lucas and Del Junco.
