Re: Franz R. Oldenburg  
a/k/a Michael Kolonowski  
(H.R. 5507)

Kindly take notice that I have this day been retained by  
Mr. Franz R. Oldenburg as his attorney to inform you as follows:

Claim is herewith made against the Central Intelligence  
Agency and/or the United States Government in the sum of \$186,500.00.

*changed:  
\$162,500.00*

Said sum is inclusive of claims of salary due to  
Mr. Oldenburg for a period of 33 months at the rate of \$14,565.00 yearly,  
plus reimbursement for additional payments of benefits. This claim is  
paid upon a contract signed between Mr. Franz R. Oldenburg and the  
Central Intelligence Agency and/or the United States of America, which  
became effective on October 7, 1963.

One of the provisions of said contract was that it could not  
be terminated unless Mr. Oldenburg was given one year notice in writing.  
Since said notice was given on October 5, 1966, the contract would in fact  
be terminated on October 6, 1966. The total claim under this contract is  
approximately \$80,000.00; the balance of the claim in the sum of \$186,500.00  
is for monies which the United States Government and the Central Intelligence  
Agency undertook to give to both Mr. & Mrs. Oldenburg at the rate of \$550.00  
per month. Demand is herewith made for the entire sum immediately, plus  
interest.

As Mr. Oldenburg's attorney, I strongly recommend that you write me for the purpose for setting up an appointment to discuss this entire matter. If I do not hear from you or your representative within 10 days, further action will be taken in this matter.

Kindly take further notice that we are reserving all rights as to future claims.

I am enclosing herewith a New York Herald Tribune's statement which speaks for itself.

I, Discharge Morris Rosoff, Esq. of  
200 Madison Avenue, New York, as  
my attorney and counselor and I  
revoke my authorization to him dated  
April 22, 1955, which was given by  
me as Aleksei Nikolaevich Romanoff,  
Hr. Apparent, Tsarevich, Grand  
Duke of Russia also known as Colonel  
Michael Goleniewski, to have ap-  
pointed another attorney for the  
Supreme Court in Hamburg with  
reference to the Anna Anderson  
claim.  
I, Aleksei Nikolaevich Romanoff,  
Hr. Apparent, Tsarevich and Grand  
Duke of Russia, also known as  
Colonel Michael Goleniewski hereby  
appoint Robert Sceller and Sons  
Publishers, Inc. 10 East 23rd Street,  
New York 10010 as my publisher  
and representative. Such appoint-  
ment has been effected by my letter dated  
September 2, 1965, Reg. No. 127617.  
Therefore all rights of said firm  
used with reference to any publica-  
tions about my person, activity and  
appointments, such as Princess Ma-  
Kropotkin and Guy Richards from  
the Journal American (see New  
York Times, December 9, 1954, titled  
Romanoffs Too) are automatically  
cancelled and revoked. Said firm  
has not paid me any monies for any  
matter printed about my person.  
The contract between the United  
States Government and me dated  
October 7, 1963 which was ratified  
by me as Colonel M. Goleniewski  
contains no reference to my real-  
ity, my heredity and my rights.  
That much was communicated by  
registered mail number 369316,  
453673 on October 12, 1964, to Mr.  
McCone, Director of C.I.A. and Hon-  
orable Falgout and by letter dated  
March 15, 1965 to Deputy Director  
of C.I.A. General Carter Reg. No.  
191555.  
I, with reference to H.R. 5507 under  
my assumed name (in Poland)  
Michael Goleniewski, I am not an  
American citizen. All reports to the  
contrary are not true. This was  
previously stated by publication dated  
Herald Tribune, July 9, 1964,  
and Frankfurter Alleoemne Zeitung,  
Nov 4, 1955.  
This notice is to preclude my rela-  
tives and others from mencloulations  
with reference to publications and  
my rights to heredity.
