(1) Ca. July 52 V-14530 turned V-14532, V-14533 and WOITSCHEV (see para 94) over to Subject, thus learning his covername and approx physical description. V-14530 alleges to have given ~~name~~ of Subject (partially incorrect covername) to the SRIS after he met Subject ca. July 1952.

(2) As Subject was closely connected with many of the operations originating from his office, he was instructed by UM to take a vacation and temporarily cease activities under the pretext of the danger evolving from an entirely separate flap. Subject, therefore, vacationed many of his employees and came to Salzburg himself in July '53.

(3) FOR VIEN, SALZ, EE: Request any traces indicating RIS or SIS connections to Subject. As he has already been traced at SALZ and EE, we naturally are only interested in information subsequent to initial trace.

(4) FOR VIEN: Subject's true identity follows under separate cover.
