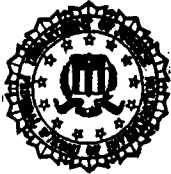

MISCELLANEOUS - INFORMATION CONCERNING

The Department of the Air Force by memorandum dated November 21, 1955, advised it had received information from Headquarters, United States Air Force in Europe, that subject is a possible Soviet agent, possibly residing in the United States, and supposedly connected with an American agency.

Subject was described in 1953, according to the Department of the Air Force, as a leader of the anti-Soviet Government-in-Exile of the Armenian Republic.

The recipients of this memorandum are requested to furnish this Bureau any information contained in their files concerning subject.
