The Department of the Air Force by memorandum dated Movember 21, 1955, eduteed it had received informatien from Mondquarters, United States Air Perces in Europe, that subject is a possible Soviet agent, possibly residing in the United States, and supposedly connected with an American agency.

Subject was described in 1953, according to the Bepartment of the Air Force, as a leader of the anti-Soviet Government-in-Exile of the Armenian Republic.
