<p>He has been associated recently with Dr. Hugo KITTEL, merchant and former Police Commissioner who worked for British intelligence. It is assumed that the two are organizing an intelligence group. The following are mentioned to be connected with the new group: Engineer RICHARD, Jalt, Langenauer Hauptstrasse 24a, former Jewish bank Ernst WILHELMSON; Hans ROSTER, former Financial Secretary of the 70th and member of the 1ST III in Salzburg. According to RICHARD-KLATT, the group is re-instated in one site in June 1950. The group is said to have been re-instated in Salzburg Security Directorate.</p>

<p>In mid June KAUDER met a former O6 officer named Saery (?) whose wife's mother Elisabeth König lives in Sals., Marcus Bittikus strasse 19. Saery claimed to be on the way to Swiss, Greece and Turkey on an intelligence mission. Kauder claims to have been given the assignment by Bar (sic) of CIC Sals. (presumably Berg) to locate persons who would be used to penetrate the KPO3 cells in various Sals. interphase. Kauder's contact with Dr. Hugo KITTEL continues. One of KITTEL's contacts to the British is allegedly thru a Dr. Hans or Viktor ALTMANN whose brother is a Police Capt. in Vienna.</p>

DATE Richard KAUDER has permanent contact with the SOURCE FILE REF.
 Salzburg merchant, Hans GUTTFELCHNIK; the contact
 visit KAUDER daily at the latter's office at Schwarzstrasse 30.
 9 May 50 Former VOJ functionary Karl H. MITSCHE is in close (CIC FOI 11599)
 connection with GUTTFELCHNIK, for whom he performs
 informative missions. MITSCHE has often been seen at KAUDER's offices.
 MITSCHE also has contact with Nationalrat Dr. Lujo TONCIC, and submits
 information to the latter. TONCIC is a candidate for the OeVP Wirtschafts-
 bund, and, in turn, is in close contact with former Minister Julius RAAB.
 MITSCHE and KAUDER are also in contact with the former Provincial Secre-
 tary of the OeVP, Salzburg, Dr. Wilfried BRAUNER, who is RAAB's secretary.
 Through the above-mentioned connections, it is certain that information
 is carried from KAUDER to RAAB. It is strongly suspected that KAUDER is
 the recipient of economic and political advantages arranged by RAAB.

19 Jan 50 KLETT claims to have been visited by Foreign Minister Karl P/O1590
 SCHNER at St. Gilgen in mid-May, 1950. KLETT allegedly dis-
 covered the organization of an Austrian intelligence system, but indicated that
 the starting date had not yet been determined. KLETT uses the art critic of the SAPO
 paper in Salzburg, "Demokratisches Volksblatt," and Mrs. Maria Scherr (phonetic) as
 informants on SAPO matters. She is getting her a job on the "Salzburger Volksblatt,"
 to begin approximately 15 June. They meet regularly at Tomaskovic's.
