21 June 50 In mid June KAUDER met a former OS officer named Baery (?) whose wife's mother Elisabeth König lives in Salz., Marcus Sittikus strasse 19. Baery claimed to be on the way to Switzerland, Greece and Turkey on an intelligence mission. Kauder claims to have been given the assignment by Bar (sic) of CIC Salz. (presumably Berg) to locate persons who would be used to penetrate the MPO3 cells in various Salz. interlopers. Kauder contacted Dr. Hugo KITTEL's contacts. One of KITTEL's contact to the British is allegedly thru a Dr. Hans or Viktor ALTMANN whose brother is a Police Capt. in Vienna.	P/02690

9 May 50 Former VOU functionary Karl H. HITZCHI is in close (CTC FBI 11599)
connection with GÖTTENSTEIN, for whom he performs
informative missions. HITZCHI has often been seen at KAUFER's offices.
HITZCHI also has contact with Nationalrat Dr. Lujo TONCIC, who submits
information to the latter. TONCIC is a candidate for the OeVP Kirtschafts-
bund, and, in turn, is in close contact with former Minister Julius RAAB.
HITZCHI and KAUFER are also in contact with the former Provincial burea-
tive of the OeVP, Salzburg, Dr. Willfried RAUWEIS, who is RAAB's secretary.
Through the above-mentioned connections, it is certain that information
is carried from KAUFER to RAAB. It is strongly suspected that KAUFER is
the recipient of economic and political advantages arranged by RAAB.

- 19 Jun 50 Elsaff claims to have been visited by Foreign Minister Klem-
mern at Mr. Jilgau in mid-May, 1950. Klemm allegedly dis-
cussed the organization of an Austrian intelligence system, but indicated that
the starting date had not yet been determined. Elsaff uses the art critic of the same
