EGU-A-7691, 18 Feb 54: In 1950 V-14,530 met in camp PARSEN former Vlasov Army Maj. PETROVSKI, Anatoli, who prepared anti Soviet propaganda caries here - camp rather than intellig. contact according to tip. in Dec 52 V-14,530 learned from Nikola WENITZKI that TBT. working for AIS and OW registered refugees and maintained cord file

EGU-A-5188, 25 Aug 53 (p. 24): ^{in P. n. 2052} V-14530 ^{with} SRS, which gave SSI in P. 33 SRS. reported him of dispatching agents in USSR to March 53 V-14530 was told to contact HEINZELMANN for further info on P. SRS exp. interested in obtaining info from P's Kable. On 3 Aug 53 V-14530 said that P's active part led to propaganda, but that Rein touch w German speaking media P b. 28 Feb 1900 E Lagovskhonski/Armour, Siberia

13 Aug 52. GV C. Field that Gen. T. had suggested using Anatoli PET. for DIP work (Gen T to get 1000 \$/mo. for maintaining the contact). Salz files showed P to be an intelligence man. POB rejected this proposal; informed O CAESAR.

Salz
ACIC v. S-1103, 6 Feb 48: Anatoli PETROVSKIY b. 28 Feb 1900 in Blagoveshchensk/Ammur, Siberia, son of Lt. Col. Was member cadet corps Pishov 1910-1917. From Oct '17 to Jan '18 fought v. Reds in Col. Sakhov's unit, hospitalized till Apr. '18. Sent to parents' home in Bohemian White Russia. Jan - Oct '18 served in 3rd Ulan Regt of Gen Gen DANKOV MOSVILKI's corps, a Polish unit in the Russian White army. Oct '18 to Sep '20 - claimed served for Polish CI unit "Zaporyzha" led by Lt. Col. ZEMSK which op'd in Bohemian area. Aug '20 (Salz remained), After Whites retreated & at home, was arrested by Reds, but released in Sep '20, for lack of evidence.

1923 in Krasnoje Sieleje married Olga BIEGUNOVA
May 1926 re-arrested by Reda^{no} on basis of
denunciations by Mikhail LOMOV, former
co-witcher in Polish Communist (1918-'22)
Because GPU could not prove the charges he
was not imprisoned but sent to E. Siberia
in "voluntary exile"

June 26 - 1933 with wife & 2 child (Georgi & Irenid)
lived in Aldan Community ca 20 km from
Blagoveshchensk/Amur, also in Arkhangel'skiy,
Maganova and Gubkharyny.

1933 2 other child: Gena and Sergei
bookkeeper and supervisor of 1-3 Kolchoz Avstrel
Obstania & Potiki vic. Bolnisk

Aug 31 - Feb 1937 w father & 40 others imprisoned by NKVD
for nothing to CR. He spent 2 years in
solitary. NKVD could not prove case so
he was set free; others were sentenced to
10 yr. convict. camp.

July '37 with 2 children, fully and ^{later} crowded up from
to into Poland. Worked as farm hand & ~~then~~
and estate manager Zuhoro, 6 km from
Pochoczan, Poland, during German occupation till
Jan 45

11 Jan 45 ordered into TADT org. - 4. day transfer
in Kutno, Poland and Frankfurt

15 Apr 45 unit dissolved; he sent to Scherwin to
work on a farm

May '45 fled West before Red army

Apr. '45 regist'd with Russ Esp Parole, only
family in Drogic

May 46 - Feb 47: Carpenter in Calzberg area

Feb 47 - ret'd to Esp Parole

15 Apr 47 - worked for Russ Esp newspaper Kultura,
Helmhorn/Solz.

'48 - believed colleague of Pluton BARKININ, ^{agent}
informant of for St. Regel. Service in Calzberg
