The regards MAX reports as first class and NORITZ as high but not first class

ELATT working with Bulg. WT network. SCHUBERT traffic, other than with Sofia, is routine Bulg. police traffic.

ELATT recommending three Bulg. Police officials for decorations including ZOMEFF (TROMEFF)

Probable that MAX reports come to Solis in Pussian language as MLATT requires Russian typewriters.

  - Excision of names, cover names and numbers of units, regiment. squadron ships, otc, since such details are rarely reported by LMK.
     Suppression of vast numbers reports remained munitions, fuel, casualties, promotions, admin and oper. orders. WT serv. instr. etc.
- B. All messages unless sent in clear must have been deciphered, translated into Gramm and edited (as above).

KLATT may be in contact, through I a, with Pussian traitors (staff officers, etc.). WAGNER tails RLATT to ask Land if Dolgov NIKOLAJ and SEMEZIN PRIEF IVANOVITSON have supplied info in Movorossisk. The former at present in custody of German troops. Both were arrested by Russian. On next day K says both unknown to Ira who will however inquire of SAMOILOV if he knows them.

"Has DOLGOV referred to 021" On day before that SEGILOV was reported by K to be in Stalingrad. "He is going further."

MORITZ Reports precisely similar in style to MAX reports. IBIS reports probably come from istanbul and concern Turkey, Syria and Egypt. IBIS is vague in content and flow is much less copious and regular. Highly improbable that IBIS source is intercept.
