3. REPORT OF INCIDENT					
<p>On 15 January 1953, Informant 3848 reported to this Agent that he had obtained information concerning the intelligence activities of Richard MAUDER-KLATT from the files of the Austrian State Police, Salzburg, Land Salzburg, Austria. Informant stated that MAUDER-KLATT became a member of the German counter intelligence in 1938 and subsequently became the head of a German intelligence organization in Sofia, Bulgaria. His German superiors regarded the information supplied by MAUDER-KLATT as generally reliable, but proper evaluation of the information was impossible since MAUDER-KLATT did not disclose the sources of his information, which allegedly were excellent within the Soviet Union. One of the operational methods used by MAUDER-KLATT was to tour the German-occupied Balkan countries as a member of a troupe of artists. In 1944 MAUDER-KLATT was stationed in Hungary where he was allegedly arrested, on an unknown date, by the German authorities on suspicion of being a double agent. After the end of World War II, MAUDER-KLATT moved to Salzburg, where he operated an export-import firm, located at Schwarzenbach 50. The firm actually served as a cover for his intelligence activities. MAUDER-KLATT allegedly maintained annual contact with an unidentified US intelligence agency, and was also employed with the British intelligence service until January 1961, at which time he was dismissed because he frequently submitted false information. During the period that MAUDER-KLATT was associated with the British intelligence, he used the cover name (fict) Richard. During 1948 - 1950 MAUDER-KLATT attempted to organize an Austrian intelligence service but due to the fact that he was known to be unreliable, he could not obtain financial support and was, therefore, unsuccessful. One of MAUDER-KLATT's contacts in the British intelligence was one Victor Altman alias McCally, a former British intelligence operator, who at one time held Austrian citizenship and who frequently visits MAUDER-KLATT. Altman is currently working for the Israel intelligence service, and MAUDER-KLATT has also been working for this organization since the beginning of 1962. In the spring of 1962, MAUDER-KLATT attempted to organize a troupe of artists to tour the Near East in order to gather information for the Israel intelligence service. Two persons who allegedly helped MAUDER-KLATT in this endeavor were Alexander Szenna alias Goffano, born 18 March 1905 in Budapest, Hungary, a dancer, Passport No. 088824, issued on 22 May 1951 in Rome, Italy; and Joss Bohac, born 4 June 1900, Passport No. 2510131, issued 7 September 1950 in Buenos Aires, Argentina. Szenna and Bohac were allegedly members of the troupe of artists with which MAUDER-KLATT operated during World War II. (C-6)</p>

4. SUMMARY			
On 20 January 1968 the files of the 430th CIC, Sub-Detachment 'A' were examined for information concerning SUBJECT and were found to contain the following information:			
Agent Report, S-10412, dated 2 December 1967, Subject: "BAUDER-KLATT, Richard, born 6 September 1930, former German intelligence Agent", reports that Richard BAUDER-KLATT was a former German intelligence agent who is allegedly working with the National League (National Ligue - NL), a Communist-front organization whose services the British intelligence had allegedly attempted to recruit. (Evaluation C-3)			
AGENT'S NOTES: 1. On 20 January 1968, the files of this Sub-Detachment were examined concerning the other personalities and organizations mentioned in this report with the following results:			
Agent Report, S-14170, dated 2 July 1968, Subject: "ALTWEIN Vilmos alias Szabolcs alias ALLAN, Alleged British Agent", reports that Altwein is an alleged British agent in contact with Richard BAUDER-KLATT. (Evaluation C-3)			
CCS Intercept No. 0006836, dated 24 September 1968, disclosed that Jozsef Halmos, Peete Restante, Salzburg, wrote Ferencs Halmos, Salny Janos utca 46 II/17, Budapest VIII, Hungary, that he had arrived two months ago from Toronto, Canada, after fifteen years absence from Europe and desired to return to Hungary.			
CCS Intercept No. 0006838, dated 17 November 1968, disclosed that Jozsef Halmos wrote Ferencs Halmos, Salny Janos utca 46 II/17, Budapest VIII, Hungary, that he had visited the Hungarian Embassy in Vienna to have his passport extended and had petitioned the Embassy to allow his return to Hungary. Halmos stated that the Hungarian Embassy was to notify him of its decision in approximately two months.			
The NL is listed as a Hungarian refugee anti-Communist resistance group in Salzburg, Austria.
