A. REPORT OF FACTS

On 22 January 1953 Liane Hudolin, born 14 April 1923 in Neusatz, Yugoslavia and her brother, Albert Hudolin, born 1 March 1929 in Neusatz, Yugoslavia, both currently residing at Villa Scharbergblick, Monacoeerstrasse 165, St. Gilgen, Land Salzburg, Austria, and at Max Gtt Platz 6, Salzburg, Land Salzburg, Austria, were interviewed by this Agent through Informant 3757. The interview, conducted in both the English and German languages, was held at the Hudolins' place of business and weekly residence, Max Gtt Platz 6, concerning Source's acquaintance with Richard KAUDEK-KLATT. Liane Hudolin stated that she was employed by SUBJECT in the position of clerk from 15 July 1950 until the end of December 1951, when she left his employ in order to work for her father. She had obtained her position with KAUDEK-KLATT through her father, Rudolf Hudolin, who had become acquainted with KAUDEK-KLATT when both were commuting on the same bus from their home in St. Gilgen to their respective businesses in Salzburg. During Liane Hudolin's period of employment, KAUDEK-KLATT was a business representative for the firm of Dr. Ing. Kraumberger, manufacturer of dental supplies with a factory in Mondsee, Land Upper Austria, Austria, and the Buermooer pressed asphalt Flooring Company (Buermooer Pressasphaltplatten-Gesellschaft), Buermooer, Land Salzburg, Austria. At the time Liane Hudolin left KAUDEK-KLATT's employ, he had also undertaken representing an electric light firm, the name of which she could not recall. KAUDEK-KLATT impressed Liane Hudolin as a good business man and a hard worker. Although KAUDEK-KLATT was nervous and easily excited, Liane Hudolin stated that she enjoyed working for him. KAUDEK-KLATT, she stated, appeared to be well educated; he once told her that he had studied in the Fremdenzister Institute near Salzburg, Land Upper Austria, considered to be one of the best high schools in Austria, and she heard from another source that he had later studied at the University of Vienna, Vienna, Austria. During World War II Liane Hudolin thought that KAUDEK-KLATT had been in the Balkans and in Hungary. Liane Hudolin first met KAUDEK-KLATT's wife, Inola or Ivy, when the latter came to KAUDEK-KLATT's office, as she did on the average of once a month. Liane Hudolin once visited KAUDEK-KLATT at his home in St. Gilgen, where he was sick at home. Inola KAUDEK-KLATT impressed Liane as being a quiet person and a modest dresser. Source stated that KAUDEK-KLATT was in the habit of coming home to St. Gilgen each evening after

work, but that during the winter of 1951 he slept during the week in the hotel apartment, Hauptstrasse 10, Salzburg, and went home only on weekends. In St. Gilgen, KAMMER-KLATT lived in a house owned by (Mrs.) Hutzendorfer, who is in the construction business, but in the summer or autumn of 1952 Ibola Kruder Klatt told Liene Hadolin that they (the KAMMER-KLATTs) were preparing to move to Grossgmain, Land Salzburg. Liene Hadolin believes that Ibola Kruder-Klatt had previously lived in Grossgmain, because during the time that she (Hadolin) was working for K. KAMMER-KLATT she had heard that Ibola was spending part of his time in Grossgmain and part in St. Gilgen. Liene Hadolin summarizes the following contacts of KAMMER-KLATT:

John L. ... res. living at Hauptstrasse, Salzburg, ... until October 1952. ... in St. Gilgen, a close personal friend of ... through her late husband, ...

AGENT'S NOTES: 1. On 28 January 1953, the files of this Sub-Detachment were checked concerning personalities mentioned in this report with the following results:

Robert Hudolin is listed as having been screened by CIC, USMA, on 25 October 1946 for employment with Public Health. He was issued a frontier pass on 23 March 1950.

Wolfgang Haberman, possibly identical with the Wolfgang Haberman mentioned in this report, born 28 April 1921 in Vienna, Austria, residing at St. Gilgen 73, Land Salzburg, Austria, is listed as a former Assistant Group Leader (Untersturmfuehrer) in the Military SS (Waffen SS), discharged by U.S. authorities to the Austrian police in Salzburg on 18 June 1947. SOI, St. Gilgen, (Inevaluated) dated 5 January 1949, accuses Haberman of refusing to register under the denazification law.

One Adolf Fisch, born 7 November 1911 in Schatzlar, residing at Willibald Hauthalerstrasse 2, Salzburg, Land Salzburg, Austria, a merchant and recipient of a frontier pass, is possibly identical with the Adolf Fisch mentioned in this report.

Dr. Renee Maruna, chemist, born 22 January 1914 in Prachatitz, residing at Kiedenburgstrasse (or Linonburgstrasse 5), Salzburg, probably identical with the Dr. Rene Maruna mentioned in this report, was a participant in a telephone conversation on 13 August 1948, monitored by the Civil Censorship Group Austria, concerning suspicious traffic in drugs.

On 22 January 1953 this Agent and Informant 3797 attempted to obtain from the District Court (Bezirksgericht) of St. Gilgen, Land Salzburg, Austria, information concerning the trial on the Hans Mann legacy of 1945. Employees of the Bezirksgericht stated that the court records of the case, which is as yet unaudited, are not available in St. Gilgen, having been temporarily removed to Vienna, Austria, to the office of the attorney general (Oberstaatsanwaltschaft) for consideration, where they are located under the file number 15 St 21145/51. It is unknown when the records will be returned to St. Gilgen. Bezirksgericht employees stated that the last will and testament of the late Hans Mann, who was survived by his minor son, Hans, Junior, and his second wife, Irma Mann, bequeathed Mann's estate to Hans Mann, Junior, but that the Austrian Government was currently attempting to confiscate the legacy. The trial, presided over by Judge Dr. Anton Sauer, took place in St. Gilgen; Sauer is available at the Land Court (Landesgericht), Salzburg, and also at the Bezirksgericht in Thalgaun, Land Salzburg, Austria. Hans Mann, Junior's legal guardian is Herr Karl KAUER-KLATT of Schanzstrasse 30, Salzburg, who is a close friend of Irma Mann. Mann knows KAUER-KLATT from Vienna, Austria, since they were both born. Bezirksgericht employees stated that KAUER-KLATT is in possession of duplicates of all the court records of the trial. (0-3)

AGENT'S NOTES: 1. The Hans Mann mentioned in the above report is possibly identical with the Grete Mann mentioned in other reports concerning Richard KAUER-KLATT.
