A. REPORT OF FINDINGS

On 18 March 1953 the mail and telephone conversations of Richard KAUDER-KIATT, Schwarzstrasse 30, Salzburg, Land Salzburg, Austria, were intercepted by the Civil Censorship Group, (CCG), Austria. On that date SUBJECT received a personal telephone call from one Mr. Kooh, in Salzburg. The CCG intercept, in the English language as received from CCG, is retained in the files of this Sub-Attachment; copies of the intercept are attached to all copies of this report as EXHIBIT I. In the course of the phone call, Kooh requested SUBJECT to call a Dr. Scharf at telephone number 60292, and ask if the doctor had left "...for the rendezvous."

Agent's Notes: The Dr. Scharf, at telephone number 60292, is identified as Dr. Eugen Scharf, born 25 March 1916, in Salzburg, currently residing at 11 Theodor Koerner Strasse, Salzburg. Scharf is currently under investigation by this Sub-Attachment for alleged Italian and Russian intelligence activity.

Richard KAUDER-KIATT is mentioned in Agent Report, S-16616, dated 2 March 1953, Subject as above, and numerous other reports as a former German Intelligence agent currently suspected of being involved in Israeli intelligence activity. (Evaluation C-3)

Agent's Notes: Files of this Sub-Attachment were examined for information concerning other personalities mentioned in this report with results as follows:

Dr. Eugen Scharf is mentioned in Agent Report, S-17016, Subject: GERUSKA, Ladislaus Theodor, Agent for Alleged Italian Intelligence Agency, and numerous other reports as a possible Russian intelligence agent. (Evaluation F-6)
