4. REPORT OF FINDINGS <p>On 21 September 1963, substantially the following information was submitted by Informant 3795 regarding SUBJECT: Informant reported that further investigation of SUBJECT's activities disclosed that SUBJECT had been closely associated with Dr. Hugo Kittel, born 2 November 1898, who is believed to be in the employ of the British Intelligence Service. Kittel held a high-ranking position in the Austrian Government in Salzburg, Land Salzburg, Austria, and Vienna, prior to 1938. During the Nazi regime Kittel served time in the Dachau Concentration Camp for alleged homosexual tendencies. After the war in 1945, Kittel was for a short period reinstated in his old position, but due to his abnormal habits he was finally dismissed. Kittel holds a certificate showing that he was a victim of the Nazis, and he comes under the protection of Hofrat Dr. Johann Boehm, police official in Salzburg. Kittel further maintains good contacts with other Austrian officials through whose influence he has obtained various licenses and concessions in the construction field. He is also licensed to serve as an expert consultant advisor on construction projects and holds a permit to operate an economic information bureau in Salzburg. Kittel went into partnership with Ernst Tree, with whom he operates a private detective agency at Leonhard-von-Sackenstrasse 49 in Salzburg. Tree was formerly employed with the Argus Detective Agency at Chiemseegasse 2, Salzburg. One of Kittel's investigators is one Dr. Soecklinger, residing at Weberfuhrstrasse 3, Salzburg. Informant stated that through Kittel's Detective agency, and while acting as a consultant on important construction projects, Kittel obtained considerable information which he was able to sell, with SUBJECT, to a foreign power. Kittel is considered a careful operator and moves his residence from time to time. The following is a list of Kittel's residences in Salzburg during the past few years: Glaserstrasse 49, Schwarzenstrasse 30, Andre Blumenstrasse 26, Leonhard-von-Kutschbachstrasse 40, Hollerstrasse 55, Reisenbergstrasse 7, Junengasse 15, and Buchreuthstrasse 15. Close friends of Kittel are Ing. Herbert Hippinger, Jr., Dr. Theodor Fell, Dr. Herm Kastrenek-Sestan, Dr. Ludwig Debus, and Paul Prandstetter. From February 1950 until April 1951 Kittel was in business with Lothar Rafael, and operated the firm Simex, which participated in a number of questionable business deals. Kittel further operated the Export & Import firm "Kittel & Bilgeri" in Innsbruck, Land Tirol, Austria, and he is part-owner of the firm Reorga in Salzburg. Informant further reports that he has been able to identify SUBJECT's interests, mentioned in previous reports as "Iby". (Ref. 1/R, S-19327, dated 15 September 1963, Subject as above) as Ibolya Kalmar, born 26 April 1916, Budapest, Hungary. Sandor Szemraun, SUBJECT's former partner, was seen departing Salzburg on the "Terra" train on 16 September 1963. (C-3)</p>
