Re transmit herewith the following references to personalities appearing in 271-442 which have not been previously reported:

### NAKI Saburo

TAKEMATSU is the code name for a secret intelligence operation presently being established by POWV. The operation is designed to provide domestic intelligence from within Japan (MATSU) as well as positive intelligence from without (TAKI). TAKEMATSU is to be named and run by Japanese personnel with POWV personnel involved only at the high policy level. The entire operation is to be financed by POWV. The following information was received from a highly reliable source on 10 January 1949:

On 28 December 1948 a meeting took place at the GIB Special Activities House in which the following were in attendance:

General ARIMURA

The meeting was initiated by  who announced that a 1940, black, four door sedan, Engine No. 1875287528, would be made available to KANAME. He also stated that Japanese typewriters had been prepared for the use of TAKEMATSU personnel.

KANAME stated that the operational plans for MATSU are being drafted. Boundaries of jurisdictional responsibility are presently being set up. Offices will be established within the following locations and with the listed persons responsible for their operations:
