MISSION RUPPERT

Communication of safe arrival

On arrival in Berlin Ruppert will place a want ad in two Berlin dailies. The papers selected are D.A.Z. and the Berliner Morgenpost. The text will appear in the want-ad section under the column Meublierte Zimmer as follows:

Exact text cannot be determined beforehand but it will be a request for accommodation with a source phone No; 66-87-46. The phone No. will be the clue to source. Will run for 3 days in both papers.

At the same time Ruppert will arrange for a post card to be sent to Switzerland. The text will contain the name Michele. This will indicate "safe arrival--mission proceeding".

A card containing the name "Lydie" in the text will indicate "Danger; send no one, or no messages".

A card containing the name "Georgette" will indicate Ruppert Arrested. Mission blown".

A card containing the name "Bobby" will indicate "Have extremely important information which I cannot send by radio, send a courier".

Communication to Agent of departure of others to join him.

A radio text will be broadcast over the German BBC program under the section "personal messages". This message will indicate to Ruppert that one or more persons have been dispatched to avail themselves of his safe address. The message should be repeated for six consecutive nights.

Text as follows: "LILY MANN ERWARTET DICH SEIT EIN(ZWEI ODER DRE) TAGE". The number of days will indicate the number of persons Ruppert should expect.

NO ONE SHOULD BE SENT TO JOIN RUPPERT BEFORE ONE MONTH AFTER DATE OF ARRIVAL
