DATE AND SOURCE OF INFO:

(KEDIA, Michael, & MICHAL, Michael). Born Georgia 1900: characterized as "intelligent, domineering, cynical, glib but not smooth, vain, calculating, a quibbler"; emigrated from Georgia with family 1921 to Istanbul; then on to Paris with uncle Constantin KEDIA; 1924 received scholarship from oil magnate Choschvaria to study law in Germany; stayed on in Germany, then returned to Paris; sometime between 1924 and 1927 started yogurt manufacture with his father in Paris; fairly successful; joined MICHAL's Caucasus: 1934 - '39 under-surface rivalry with MICHAL; established relations with German officials outside of Lausanne group; got behind-the-scenes support from German officials; immediately before war went to Berlin to combat influence of small group of Georgian basis livli. there; on return to Paris stopped Lausanne and had violent fight with MICHAL; when Germans arrived Paris MICHAL made director of Caucasian migration; became leader of all Georgian relations with Germans; great organizer, reconciled all differences among Caucasians; anti-Menshevik but a good friend of Jendelian who submitted to subject's overall direction during war; cooperated with Germans on sole basis that Germany should help him to regain Georgian independence; used his influence to save Jendelian group which was in bad spot because they had declared war on Germany, Lithuania, and USSR; saved Georgian Jewish emigres in Paris; For information on subject's activities with German intelligence during war,
