1. Reference is made to previous communication between this Bureau and your Bureau on the subject, the most recent of which is our G.M.C. report entitled Jan. 26, 1952, forwarded to this Office on 21 March 1952.

2. Check of files of this Office disclosed the following pertinent facts with respect to individual 16-1051, identified with reference to your G.M.C. Report:

a. A copy of a letter dated 23 November 1947 from Lt. Col. L. M. Clegg addressed to General Curtis LeMay, containing a copy of a letter from Lt. Col. Clegg to an Army officer dated 10 January 1948, both of which were forwarded to the Army 3, 1948, by 1948 to the Department of the Army.

b. On 17 July, 1950 the Department of the Army forwarded a copy of a report to the Agent from the Chief Personnel Officer at which date the report dated 15 July 1950 pertaining to Francis McNamee.

c. On 13 April 1951 this Office received a report concerning the receipt of a file back pertaining to individual 16-1051 dated 17 May 1950. This report advised that it was forwarded to General Curtis LeMay (L.C. 195103), and the report further set out information concerning all contacts between individual 16-1051 himself, who is an agent in the referenced command.

3. It is assumed that the Department of the Army has forwarded a copy of the above report to your Bureau. In the event that it is not the case, we will request records from the Army in彷求 you will forward on of the Department of the Army. The file of this Office reflects no additional pertinent information concerning individual 16-1051.

As I view of the above character of his "evidence" or the above-narrated facts we note from him to this Agency by the Army, this Agency shall make his allegation, a not warrant a claim upon the allegations in the field without consideration of the illustrations. Since, "the big majority in your Bureau that has been contact with me as my proof of his allegation, this Agency will attempt to obtain at least a portion of these files with a demand of evidence to this Agency. Therefore, it is requested that permission be granted by your Bureau to supply a copy of the file front to the appropriate British service in order to enliven their interest in this subject's subsequent assistance in obtaining the portion of the files referred to in the matter of Earl Kildare, British Army (British Service); my visit and information obtained by this Agency to this point concerning the Earl or his friends mentioned in previous communication on the subject will be forwarded to your Bureau when required.
