3. We have two references to Dr. Martin KEMNITZ []

a. EGMA-31773, 30 January 1958, was a CATUSE request for a BDC check on Subject, whom they identified as a Vertragsangestellter.

b. EGMA-42172, 12 May 1959, reported that Dr. jur. Martin H. KEMNITZ, a tenant at the Thieuestrasse-Kaulbachstrasse housing development, was "at least circumstantially connected with CATUSE".

4. On Eduard DILG [] we have no information in addition to EGMA-68267, 21 March 1966, and EGMW-14962, 25 May 1966, both of which should be available to Munich.

5. Our file on Johannes HORNISSEL [] contains the following information:

- a. A UJVENTURE sheet (3 pages).
- b. MGLA-1322, 21 February 1950, forwarded a report on the CATUSE Press Evaluation Section which HORNISSEL joined in summer 1947. His brother, Klaus HORNISSEL, joined this section in early 1949.

c. WGLA-26544, 8 February 1951, forwarded information from Composite Group files about Subject's denazification and about a counterfeit 100 DM note that Subject stated had been paid him as part of his monthly salary.

d. A carded reference to WGLA-5888, 29 March 1951, stated that BOMBIERI was a "Hauspfarrer" for CATUSK. He took "care of Protestant births, christenings, confirmations, weddings, and burials"; kept CATUSK informed on Bishop NEIMOLLER; and was CATUSK's staff contact to Bishop HECKEL.

e. WGLA-3635, 15 May 1953, stated that Subject lived at Arlaching 57 or Bergees Kreis Hanau.

f. WGLA-8109, June 1954, stated that BOMBIERI had been in touch with Georg ELSTER following ELSTER's return to Munich on 24 January 1954. ELSTER had returned from a Moscow prison with the mission of reporting on CATUSK.

g. We have two references to Gerhard KROLL [] born 6 March 1923.

a. HYI: A routine trace request from LHTSMA and LHENGO dated 22 November 1957 stated that Subject, who resided in Hannoverstuecken, had come to the United States in order to attend a U.S. Naval School (for electronic technicians) at Great Lakes, Illinois.

b. Our reply dated 20 February 1958 mentioned an individual who may or may not be identical. The following may be passed to CATUSK. A report dated 1 December 1949, from a source whose reliability cannot be judged, indicated that one Gerd KROLL, born in 1923 at Berzdorf, Germany, was a member of the police in Bernau, East Germany, and was an alleged informant for the Russian Security Police.

7. Gerhard KROLL [] was born 20 August 1910. He is or was a CATUSK special connection.
