1. Thank you for sending the above reference memoranda describing the recruitment of Subject. As soon as we have received PRQ Pt. I we shall proceed with the necessary name checks and request for operational clearance.

2. We assume that you will send us the results of Subject's psychological assessment by [] as soon as these become available. On the basis of your description of Subject in reference memoranda, however, he appears to offer good possibilities for becoming a head agent and recruiter of a W/T agent or agents.

3. We appreciate (via remote control) Subject's difficulty in finding a suitable W/T agent who can absent himself or herself long enough for training purposes. It appears, however, that several of the female prospects mentioned in MGBA-11472 (we do not have MGBA-11473 yet) might prove satisfactory since they can absent themselves without arousing undue suspicion, provided that the necessary excuses can be arranged.

4. Subject's plan for the acquisition of a garden-house has our full approval; particularly so because of the successful garden-house arrangement worked out by [] for one of the KIBITZ agents. [], now at headquarters, will provide [] with a detailed drawing of the KIBITZ housing proposition prior to [] departure for Berlin. We think that this new "wrinkle" may prove to be at least one of the answers for the caching of radios and equipment.
