1. SPILL-1761 forwarded information on Friedrich LINDBERT and Otto WARR, who are possibly identical with KIBITZ 123 and 122 respectively. We are attaching hereto a picture of LINDBERT to assist you in making a more positive identification.

The following traces do not appear to be identical with your Walter DIEM, but are forwarded because of the proximity of Mains to Kaiserlautern.

MGL-15917

Walter DIEM, a divinity student from Mains, attended the 5th Plenary Session of the German Peace Committee in East Berlin held 24 November 1951.

MGL-9843

Walter DIEM of Mains is a member of the Staendige Komitee Junger Friedenskaempfer which directs the political activity of PDJ in West Germany. Its address is 12 Complate Frankfurt.

Walter DIEM is listed as a participant at the World Peace Council which took place in East Berlin 1-5 July 1952.
