1. Subject of reference, the former V-19331, has been assigned the number V-14802. He was personally recommended by V-14400, who of course knows him as a wartime SD Amt VI colleague. He was carried briefly in the VIENNA Forscher Group under the direction of V-14801, dropped in February 1952 because the specific project he was to develop did not materialize, and is now proposed as a permanent member of the investigative and spotting network U/M is attempting to build up in VIENNA under V-14801, and as a case officer to develop and handle persons spotted in VIENNA.
