5. Vienna Operations Group:

was most probably employed by the Soviets. He was seen getting out of an automobile known to be a KGB operational vehicle. A short time later he came up with a story that sounds completely ridiculous: that of a Soviet dead drop he had discovered in Vienna. He asked for help in surveying the drop and received the assistance of two ZIPPERites whom we must assume are now known to the Soviets. At this juncture we felt forced to inform ZIPPER of our suspicions. This had heretofore been forbidden because of the sensitivity of
