1. UPSWING reported to MP-1D that Marianne LIEBSCHER's name had
come up among the BEAs assigned to an UPSWING double agent. Because of
speculations that she might be employed in an American office, UPSWING
contacted MP-1D and asked if she were indeed so employed. Local Army
personnel files showed that she was employed in the Administrative Branch
of SACOM Special Services as a clerk-typist. That office is situated in
Room 195, Building 7 (SACOM Headquarters) on McGraw Kaserne in Munich.
UPSWING was informed that she was employed at SACOM Headquarters and that
because of the security considerations an appropriate report to CIC would
be required. It was also requested that UPSWING not authorize the agent
involved to pass any material on LIEBSCHER without our specific prior
approval. A translation of UPSWING's report of the matter is forwarded as
separate cover attachment A.

2. The attached UPSWING report was officially brought to the atten-
tion of the SACOM G-2 on 8 August 1958 in his office which is located in
the same building as the Special Services Office. He expressed great
interest in UPSWING's report and stated that another woman employed in the
same office had come to him a few months ago to report that her husband
had been offered a considerable sum of money to act as an agent of the
Czech IS. Noting that CIC to whom he had forwarded the report was probably
still interested in the case, he suggested that a copy of UPSWING's report
be provided for the CIC Munich Field Office. In the interests of expediency
a copy of the report was given to the SACOM G-2 who in turn passed
it to the CIC Munich Field Office on 8 August 1958.
