We have been informed by UPSWING that Alfred KLAUSNITZER (born 4 July 1900 in Oberleutensdorf, CSR, V-6337) died of a heart attack sometime during mid-December 1958.</p> <p>2. There reportedly had been no significant developments in the case since September 1958 when, in Austria, KLAUSNITZER met his StB courier contact for the last time. That meeting was reportedly routine in nature and there was, according to the responsible UPSWING CE operations officer, nothing of significance to the AIS in KLAUSNITZER's account thereof. Also, there reportedly was no contact between KLAUSNITZER and the employee of U.S. Army Special Services, Marianne LIEBSCHER, his cousin, whose name appeared among EEI's assigned to him by the StB (reference b).</p> <p>3. UPSWING has promised us a copy of the forthcoming review of the entire operation (Fall MEPHISTO). This will be forwarded upon receipt. Also, a dispatch will be prepared on a CIC double agent case being run against the StB which we have learned about unofficially in the course of locally coordinating the LIEBSCHER angle.</p> |   |                                       |
