Born 29 January 1904 in Marlenwerder/Ostpr. GERMANY

Subject is also mentioned as Ministerialdirigent in the German Primer.

2. According to February 1953 information one Bruno Peter von
KLEIST, no birth data, is a friend of Arth. REISS, born
24 March 1906 in Stuhm, West Prussia. REISS, alias REITER, is an UPHILL
staff member who is now active in an UPHILL Aussenstelle (political opera-
tions within the alias WINTERSTEIN complex). REISS is an expert on the
Baltic countries and on Poland. REISS was reported in Warsaw in 1939 and
in 1941 was deputy editor and chief of the political office of the "Ost-
deutschen Beobachter" in Posen. It is probable that KLEIST is identical
with Subject and that he and REISS became acquainted during the war.
