KNORR, Hauptsturmführer  
Herbert      German: born 21.6.08: with KdS Lvov in January 1943: appointed Ustuf. on 9.11.35: promoted Ostuf. on 20.4.38 when in the SD: Party No. 135,397: SS No. 4,296: married with a child born about June 1943.

KNORRE, Dr. Werner von      German: born 2.4.99: D.N.B. correspondent in Stockholm: suspect SD official: reported in 1944 to be working under instructions of FINKE: married. Address: (1942) 3 Brahevågen, Stocksund, Stockholm (tel. 55 39 86): (1943) 2 Frejavågen, Stockholm.

KNORRING, Baron Hermann      (?) German: director of the Kegel Works in Estonia, where he was reported to be a German agent in September 1939.

KNORT, Dr.      German: reported in December 1941 to be working as interpreter to SCHIFFBAUER in Athens.

KNOTE or KNOTH      See KNOTHE, Oberstleutnant

KNOTH, Sonderführer Dr.      German: Gruppe II Athens in February 1942: recalled to Berlin later in the month after he had been punished for a breach of discipline.

KNOTHE or KNOTH  
or KNOTE, Oberst-  
leutnant      German: reported to be head of the Propagandaastaffel, Paris, with offices at 52 Champs Elysees: came to notice before the war as having supervised the translation of "Mein Kampf" into Indian languages, and was stated also to have handled propaganda directed against the Balkans, having been, during the last war, an intelligence officer in Bulgaria: his brother was stated in 1938 to be private secretary to GOEBBELS.

KNUDSEN, Direktor      See BLUHM, Oberleutnant

KNUDSEN, Oskar      See KIESEL, Kapitänleutnant Otto

KNUPPEN, Oberschar-  
führer      German: born Kassel 1907: Gestapo: driver at Dubrovnik (Dalmatia) late in 1943: formerly a Gestapo driver in the Kassel area and later served with Kdo 10 B in Russia: tall, well-built, full face, fair hair with a marked parting, pointed chin, ruddy complexion.

KNUTH, Untersturmführer  
u. Kriminalsekretär  
Artur      German: born 3.8.00: Amt IV RSHA in June 1943, when he was commended by HIMMLER for his work on a case in the Innsbruck area: appointed Ustuf. on 9.11.38: in SD in December 1938: Party No. 5,499: SS No. 272,580.

KOARIC, Jaeger      German: attached to II/4 Brandenburg Regiment in the Balkans in December 1943.

KOBEL      German: born c.1907: employed in the Central Registry (ZK) Abwehr Amt in the second half of 1942 on the letters A-B in the alphabetical index: not a Party member: married with three children: height 5'6" (168 cm): rather stout, dark hair.

KOBENZ      See KEBENZ

KOBER, Erwin  
© CORBATTI, Enrico      German: saboteur in 16/4 Brandenburg Regiment: in Sardinia in September 1943: held false papers describing him as a clerk, born Forli 10.9.24.

KOBERG, Hauptmann      German: I W1 Ast Niederlande: probably attached from Nest Cologne: visited Madrid in October 1942 for a conference with LENZ, Leiter KO Spain.

KOBLER, Unteroffizier      German: I1 (W/T operator) Abwehr Amt in the second half of 1942.

© KOLTER      German: born Bydgoszcz 1900: IH KONO since his arrival in Istanbul on 17.9.43: acted as assistant to LEVER-KUEHN, on whom he none the less reported adversely to Berlin after the Abwehr defections of July 1944: left for Berlin on 23.2.44, and was understood not to be returning: Prussian Junker, untravelled and uneducated but energetic and a hard worker: passport No. 3085 issued Berlin 9.9.43. KOBROW, Gefreiter      German: I1 (W/T operator): transferred from Naples to Merano by the end of September 1943.
