Recently, through the efforts of SHIMADA (fnu), president of the Hokkaido Colliery and Steamship Company Ltd., KODAMA gained control of the Hokkaido Construction Company, Ltd., ousting SEKINE (fnu), the former president. The Hokkaido Construction Company is reported to be a major source of funds for The ultra-nationalist activities of KODAMA, who is closely affiliated with TSUJI Masanobu, MIURA Giichi, and the HATCYAMA Faction of the Liberal Party. TSUJI, former colonel and one of Japan's best known ultranationalists, is presently an independent member of the House of Representatives. is affiliated with numerous rightists groups, and heads the Toa Remmei Doshikai.
