BACKGROUND AND ACCESS OF AGENT:

Subject is a Director and the export manager of one of the largest companies in the Koln area with interests on a world wide basis. In this capacity he travels extensively although his travels, as of this date, have not taken him to the China/N. Vietnam/N. Korea areas. Subject acting in the dual capacity of Chief, Secretariat and Export Mgr of the above company has access to top executives in other companies, such as Siemens, TYPE OF AGENT COMMUNICATIONS: who are actively involved in China trade.

At the moment, contact with Subject is confined to his office and the company's private dining room.

TARGETING: (including OD citation) A-3

Subject has been requested to place the C.O. in direct contact with a Far Eastern expert from Siemens, with Henschel Werke executives concerned with the China trade and to keep us informed if his company becomes directly involved in the China scene.

OPERATIONAL DEVELOPMENTS: (include security aspects and training)

The C.O. was originally introduced to Subject by the Subject of [] 74434, the President of the Corporation who was a former acquaintance of Mr. Edmund Kellogg, the former U.S. ConGen in Dusseldorf. This case is still in an embryonic stage of development largely attributable to the fact that Subject is not infrequently on the road and, when at the H.C., is naturally preoccupied with the myriad details attendant to running a corporation employing more than 30,000 people. However, the company has close relations with AT&T and does various contractual work for INHARP. Perhaps the above coupled with a new sensitivity toward the Communist menace stemming from the Soviet invasion of Czechoslovakia will facilitate our efforts, which, at this moment, are largely confined to defining our targets and needs.

ACTION TAKEN PER PREVIOUS HEADQUARTERS REVIEW:

Not applicable. This is a new developmental operation which had its genesis on 24 April 1968.

PRODUCTION: (include significant operational information)

There has been no intelligence production/^{as} of this date. Operational information obtained has pertained primarily to the company's activities and to an offer to introduce the C.O. to a Siemen's officer concerned with Far Eastern matters.

EVALUATION AND RECOMMENDATIONS:

FINDS:

Recommend continuation of developmental activity, which costs us nothing is not very time consuming and is at a level which could constitute a constructive bridge to people in the China trade should Subject decide firmly that such cooperation is in his company's interests.
