SUBJECT: VISAS: Refusal of Visa to Yoshitaka KOMIYA (小宮義孝)

Under the provisions of Title 22, Section 53.33 (a) and Title 22, Section 53.33 (k), Code of Federal Regulations, Dr. Yoshitaka KOMIYA, who has made application for a Section 3(1) Government Officials visa, was informally refused a visa on April 2, 1952. In this connection, the following information is furnished:

1. Name of Alien: Yoshitaka KOMIYA
2. Date of Birth: February 18, 1900
3. Place of Birth: Saikama Prefecture, Japan
4. Nationality: Japanese
5. Travel Document: Japanese Government Official Passport No. 10086, issued January 25, 1952
6. Reasons for Refusal: Inadmissible as alien whose entry would be prejudicial to the interests of the United States.

REMARKS:

Dr. KOMIYA applied for an official visa at this office to proceed unaccompanied to the United States. Dr. KOMIYA has been attached to the Japanese National Institute of Health since January 15, 1950 and presented letters of invitation from the University of Oklahoma and Johns Hopkins University. Copies of this correspondence are attached for your information.

On the basis of information received from the Controlled American Source and G2, Dr. KOMIYA's visa application was refused by a board of three consular officers at this Mission
