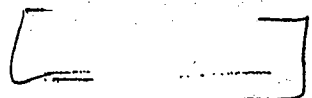

From March to September 1944 was a driver with Frupp 123;
in December 1944 transferred to Kommando 33.

Source stated that in Leipzig he often used to see
~~the~~ ~~subject~~, who was with the East Front for a time Chief of
 the Directorate General of Police in ~~the~~ ~~Netherlands~~ and later
 fought as an officer at the East Front against the
 Russians. According to source, ~~the~~ ~~subject~~ was said to hold
 a prominent post in the G.S. in Leipzig.
