1. We regret the delay in replying to your request for further information on ~~WILHELM~~, but the [Dutch] report has only now reached Headquarters. [Dutch] reports the following additional information:

a. According to information received from a Dutch subject released from Russian captivity, ~~WILHELM~~ was detained in the 'Peter and Paul Fortress' in Leningrad from 1945 to 1947. Thereafter, he was detained in one or more camps until in 1950 he was sentenced to 25 years' imprisonment in Kiev.

b. After his release ~~WILHELM~~ arrived on 28-10-53 at the Friedland Camp in Western Germany; he did not want to repatriate to the Fatherland, but preferred to stay in Western Germany. Many of subject's former co-prisoners thought that ~~WILHELM~~ behaved very well in captivity.

c. After the war a rumor was afloat in quarters of informed political observers that ~~WILHELM~~ was in the Eastern zone of Germany, and had entered Soviet employment as broadcaster with the Function radio. G. WILHELM's information (see paragraph b of second reference) that he had several times met subject, who was working for the Russian Intelligence Service at Leipzig, may presumably refer to this rumor, as informant--he has meanwhile been found unavailable--also stayed for some time in detention camps after the war.

d. As the said rumor and WILHELM's information have in no way been credibly confirmed, and they are moreover contradicted by the admissions given above about ~~WILHELM~~, we do not attach any value to the rumor in question.

e. We do not object to your passing the above data to the States.
