2. Subject held post of Chancellor of the Holy Autocephalic Church of Poland in Germany. Was Chief of Security Service (SS) of the Foreign Section of the organization of Ukrainian Nationalists led by Stefan BANDERA (ZCh/OUN or OUN/B) until 1948 when he left this organization and concentrated his intelligence efforts for KUBARK.

2. Michael KORZAN married Marianna Elisabeth MOEKVA in November 1936 in Lvov, Ukraine. In 1937, he was arrested by the Polish Police and sentenced to 12 years

imprisonment for his activities in the OUN. During this time Michael KORZAN's wife was unfaithful to him and he wrote to her giving her a free hand in a divorce. She did not take advantage of the offer.

In September 1939, Michael KORZAN was released from prison during the German attack on Poland. In early 1940 he again met his wife and they were reunited to avoid a public scandal. In June 1941 Subject went to the front lines and his wife again took up with another lover. In 1944 she fled with a German officer to Slovakia and later to Vienna. From mid 1944 until her appearance in Munich in July 1954, Michael KORZAN had no contact with her.

In the meantime, Michael KORZAN began working with the German Abwehr in Cracow and one Irene Yaroslavna BIEUS was appointed as his assistant by the Germans. The two were entrusted with housing of captured Russian agents and watching over their wireless communication. Lest the Russian Agents become suspicious, the Germans ordered the two to pretend to be a married couple. With this end in mind, BIEUS was furnished with false documents made in Michael KORZAN's name though the two had never contracted a marriage.

In the middle of April 1945, the two were sent on a mission to Austria by the Germans. They registered with the authorities as husband and wife and after Germany's collapse Michael KORZAN received an Austrian Kennkarte. When he was transferred to Munich in 1947, the couple received German documents on the basis of registration with the police. The first falsification of documents took place in Munich in 1940, when KORZAN presented IRO with a false marriage certificate in regard to an alleged marriage in Krakow. Later, a copy of this false marriage certificate was given to the German police in Munich during October 1952, when a Reisesurweis was issued to Irene.

The matter was resolved by having Michael KORZAN and BIEUS go to the German court and clarify their relationship. This was done on 27 July 1954 and KORZAN's marital status was changed in the Munich Registration Office. On 31 December 1954, Michael KORZAN and his legal wife Marianna nee NOGKVA were divorced by German court. KORZAN was now rid of both women.

On 3 April 1956, Irene BIEUS emigrated to Canada where she established herself in the cosmetics business with the help of \$1500 from Michael KORZAN. In October 1956, KORZAN's divorced wife emigrated to the United States. He now has no further obligations to either women.

Section XVI - Biographic data on Michael KURZAN.

1. Subject, born 11 November 1912, in Zakomarie, Western Ukraine, became a member of the Ukrainian Military Organization (OVO) in 1928, and upon reorganization of the latter group, entered into the Organization of Ukrainian Nationalists (OUN) in 1929. He became an instructor of an illegal underground youth section of the OUN in January 1934, and upon arrest of many of the leaders of the OUN homeland executive committee in November 1934, Subject was given duties as Organization Referent. In 1935, Subject became publisher of a nationalistic, anti-Bolshevik newspaper of the OUN and was arrested by the Polish government in September 1935 and imprisoned for three months. He was again arrested in July 1937 by the Polish government and was released in September 1939 upon outbreak of the German-Polish war.

2. Upon direction of OUN officials, Subject agreed, in November 1939, to become a member of the German counterintelligence service. Until April 1945, Subject served, on a regular and part time basis, with various sections of the German intelligence service and was awarded several decorations for his successes in counterintelligence operations directed against the USSR.

3. Subject, who had earlier studied at a theological school, was ordained during the latter part of 1944. From September 1945 to April 1957, he was employed as an instructor in a private Ukrainian gymnasium at Salzburg, teaching courses in the Bible and in Latin, and also served as representative of the Anti-Bolshevik Block of Nations (ABN) in Salzburg, and the Tryol. Since April 1947, Subject has been residing in Munich, where he has held the post of Chancellor of the Holy Autocephalic Church of Poland in Germany. He was chief of the Security Service (SS) of the Foreign Section of the Organization of Ukrainian Nationalists led by Stefan BANDERA (ACH/OUN or OUN/B) until August 1948 when he left this organization and concentrated his intelligence efforts for KUBARK. From 1948 until the present time Subject has been in operational contact with this Agency.
