The following supplementary information has been established about the secretary and "right hand" of Prof. LUEDKE - the leader of the Orthodox section of the "League Universalis Christiania":

Exact name and profession (according to his papers): Professor, Doctor (Orthodox archbishop) MIHAIL CORZAN.

Address: MUNICH; Hereog Heinrichstr. 38/II, in care of HASENAU. The following shield hangs on the door: "Holy Autokephal Orthodox Church of Poland in Germany. Officially recognised by World Councill Church World Service."

CORZAN comes from LEMBERG (Galicia) and is the some of a former Austrian officer of Polish descent. Those who know him say that he is very smart.

The source, who received CORZAN's address from MFALLER, visited the former. CORZAN about the purpose of the visit and also who sent the source to him. The source referred to Polish names which CORZAN immediately noted down.

When he learned that the source and several of his friends were interested in the "League", CORZAN said that if the source really wants to participate in the work his first mission would be to make everyone mindful of the fact that the "League Universalis Christiania" is not communistic. The leadership of the League is not responsible for the fact that the communists join it.

MREK CORZAN said that he came into the League through PfALLER on whose advice he went to ESSEN to convince himself that the movement of the League has nothing in common with communism, and that, he himself has nothing he in common with the communists and is a refugee from Poland, since de does not sympathize with the regime there.

On 24.2.51 CORZAN was with IUEDKE in order to receive money. The amount of the sum has not been established. CORZAN attributed great significance to the conference of the "World Peace Council" of 21-24.2.51 to which IUEDKE was also supposed to go in order to give a lecture. However he Hid not receive permission for the trip and confined himself to sending his lecture by express post along with a telegram in which he insast@d that a delegation of the congress be despatched to DUESSEIDORF with the aim of influencing BONN.
