He is connected with the s/m persons and, as a steady visitor of the "WOEMCHAT", he is according to new information a participant in the arms sales which have lately been going on in Woemcount (Escalatrases No 2) and in which Soviet criminal elements are participating. An automatic pistol with 14 certridges may be bought for 120-130 DM. If 100 automatic pistols are bought, the price decreases down to 90 DM. Automatic pistols for 150-180 DM are also sold. The information cases frum the wives of the bandits who are not in on the arms deals and who therefore cannot give complete and exact information on this matter.

For technical reasons, the purchase of arms in this manner is not possible.

The sindowing of Dr Mihail CONDAN, the orthodox primet who is behind Prof.

CORPAN years civilian clothing despite his clerical position. He speaks a Wolinian-Ukraunian dialect. He lives with his wife in a room where he also has his office (Herrog Heinrichstrasse, No 38/II). He knows the history of

It was reported in F No 4044 that Bishop SAWA-SOURTON had dealings with the Soviet agent KTWATSCHIX (SERMORE) and had contact with the Moscov Batriarch. There is no information concerning the termination of these contacts.

According to CONZAN, SANNA-SONETON is a follower of the "Liga Universalis Christians" and of the "Stockhom Appeal." CONZAN moveover said that he belongs to a Church organization which does not concern itself with the recruiting of members; that is done by the "Liga" which presches simultaneously the seagurable meet of the churches and the fight against war. During the conversation, CONZAN tried to emphasize his personal acquaintanceship with anti-Sowiet orthodox priests.

At the end, CORZAN ugain asked the source about these who had sent him into the "Liga". He was notified with the answer and promised to give instructions for the work as well as material aid for railroad trips, and asked the source issudiately to find a room for a Polish friend who had just arrived in Number. He did not say from where this friend had come. The reporter has found outh that CORZAN's wife is corresponding with Poland.

Already in 1948, the priest Alexander KISSILEW, former Priest at Manerkirchemetrasse So 5, who has emigrated to the UCL, and the Priest Georg BENIUSON, former Russian clergymen in Hamburg, had contact with the LUDKE organization. This contact has been estudiated by wesering MCHREDIE, the former chairman of the stedent union of the UEGA University, who had aslo emigrated to the UEA.

Regarding Malerij MICHELSON, the following was reported in P No 4869, (20 May 49):

- 1) Former Lieutement of EKVD troops;
- 2) Close to YMCA circles, through which he is commented with the Priest ETHSTRIBE:
 - · 3) Contact with the EAT-ATKIE circles and AMERICACE.
 - b) Contact with K. BILDEREG, a shady personality (F No 2757, 2798, 4310).
 - 5) French Intelligence has shown interest in W. MICHELSON.

As known, N. FARRIZIDS was active in the movement of Church Unification and thus, according to source, had frequent contact with LUDIZ.
