Subject: Engagement of CAPELIN as independent Contractor.

1. In accordance with the terms of the AERODYNAMIC/CAPELIN project, the individual named above has been engaged, under oral contract, for a term of indefinite duration. The effective date of this contract is 1 January 1952.

2. Subject remains currently an AERODYNAMIC asset but is now being processed within the CART complex under designation of AKBATH. When the AKBATH project receives final approval, AERODYNAMIC financial obligations will cease and AKBATH funds will be drawn upon.

3. Until further notice, the sum of 500 DM will be paid to the Subject each month. In addition, an escrow dollar account in Subject's name will be opened in the United States, with deposits of 100 dollars per month as part of Subject's salary. A termination bonus, from one to three months salary, has been promised. A Christmas bonus in accordance with existing organizational regulations has been promised. Reimbursements for authorized travel, official telephone, telegraph, photographic and photostatic needs, postal and other expenses, including per diem, will be allowed in accordance with mission directives.


4. Special equipment allowed Subject include a Ukrainian typewriter, English typewriter, photo-copying equipment, MINOX camera.

5. In accordance with oral contract, Subject will receive 6 cartons of cigarettes, 2 pounds of coffee, 1 pound of tea, and two bottles of whiskey per month.

6. Subject and his wife ^{HPW} has been promised assistance in the event of evacuation, flight, evacuation, and immigration, including free transportation for subject and wife to U.S.

7. Termination of oral contract may be made upon oral notice by either party.

8. No commitments other than those above have been made to Subject.
